GENERAL PURPOSE WORK-OVER PAPER

USES: Fortifiber Building Systems Group® Utility Paper is commonly used as a temporary and disposable general purpose work-over paper to protect surfaces from foot traffic, wall and ceiling texture overspray and paint drippings. Although not waterproof, it provides some water and moisture resistance.

An economical, multi-purpose building paper, Fortifiber Utility Paper is used in a variety of common residential and commercial construction applications as a separation sheet between other building products. It is often used as a “slip-sheet” in built-up roofs, under rigid foam in roof structures, and between the sub-floor and wood flooring to help control dust, drafts and noise.

DESCRIPTION: Fortifiber Utility Paper is a single-ply, heavyweight, hard-sized kraft paper. Neutral in color, it contains no dye. Fortifiber Utility Paper is “Made in the USA”.

ROLL SIZE: 36" x 167' (500 sq.ft.)

PROPERTIES: Fortifiber Utility Paper is available in a 17 lb. roll with a basis weight of 3.5 lbs./100 sq.ft. It is recyclable and resistant to bleed-through.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS: In system applications, follow directions of specifier or system manufacturer. In general, clean surface of all debris to avoid puncture of the utility paper. Unroll and cut paper to desired length and, as needed, overlap paper a minimum of 4"-6". Tape seams as required for the specific application.

STORAGE: Store product in a dry, clean environment free from excessive heat or cold.

LIMITATIONS: Fortifiber Utility Paper is not flame-retardant and is not waterproof. Avoid use in high moisture areas. Contact Fortifiber’s Technical Assistance for information on available flame-retardant and moisture-resistant products. Fortifiber Utility Paper does not qualify as hazardous material under OSHA’s hazardous communications standards. An MSDS sheet is not required for this product.
